## **Ethical Approval Decision**

## Upon the Request of MTA TK "Lendület" RECENS Research Group

Concerning the Project "Feasible Peer Effects—How Seat Neighbours Influence Each Other in the School" founded by National Research, Development and Innovation Office under the Grant Number FK125358

Data collecting methodology and procedure as well as the recruitment of participants have been screened by the Ethics Review Committee of the Centre for Social Sciences at Hungarian Academy of Sciences and approved beforehand by the Institutional Ethics Review Board.

This decision is based on the following documents: (1) Data Handling Statement; (2) Letter to Schools; (3) (Statement of Intent); (4) Parental Agreement; (5) Signed letter.
